## **Code of Conduct**

### **Respect and Courtesy**

All members and visitors must treat each other with respect and courtesy. Any form of abuse, harassment, or discrimination will not be tolerated.

### **Handling Issues**

If a Member encounters any issues, they should first discuss the matter with their team captain (for league games) or approach a club officer (as defined in the club's constitution) for other concerns.

### **Awareness of Chess Rules**

All players should ensure they are familiar with the rules of chess. If uncertain, they should seek clarification from a team captain or a knowledgeable club member.

### **Venue Respect**

Members must respect the venue and its property by keeping the space clean and refraining from bringing outside food and drink. Supporting the venue by purchasing refreshments helps maintain our arrangement with Fishguard & Goodwick Rugby Club

### **Social Media and Online Conduct**

Members must not post or share defamatory, offensive or harmful content about the club, its members, or affiliated organisations on social media or any online platforms. Breaches of this policy will be taken seriously and may result in disciplinary action.

### **Adherence to Club Policies**

All members must comply with club policies and guidelines set by the Executive Committee. Failure to do so may result in a punishment at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
